CHANGE / CANCELLATION PENALTIES ASSESSED BY CARNIVAL:

Cancellations after deposit are subject to a \$200 per person service fee.

Cancellations after May 5, 2009 – 50% cancellation fee per person

Cancellations after June 5, 2009 – 75% cancellation fee per person

Cancellations after July 2, 2009 - No Refund

Name changes prior to May 5, 2009 - \$50 change fee will apply

Name changes after May 5, 2009 - \$100 change fee will apply

Note – If Cancellation/Interruption Insurance is purchased, a reimbursement of penalties will be provided by Insurance Company if cancellation occurs due to illness, death or other specific unforeseen circumstances.

GROUP CANCELLATION / INTERRUPTION INSURANCE – Highly Recommended

SPECIAL GROUP Cancellation / Interruption Insurance has been negotiated for Crime Stoppers USA. A minimum of 10 participants is required.

- Cost is **\$99** per person, age 0-60, for up to \$1500 coverage per person
- Cost is **\$169** per person, age 0-60, for up to \$3000 coverage per person
- Cost is **\$129** per person, age 61 +, for up to \$1500 coverage per person
- Cost is **\$209** per person, age 61 +, for up to \$3000 coverage per person

Cancellation/Interruption Insurance protects the traveler against monies lost, up to 100% of trip cost, if cancellation/interruption occurs, due to medical reasons, death and/or jury duty, to the traveler, traveler companions, and/or immediate family members. This includes reimbursement of the unused portion of your trip, as well as increased transportation costs for you to return home due to a covered reason. If insurance is purchased at time of initial deposit, coverage will also include pre-existing conditions, Terrorist Incident in a U.S. city or financial default of a supplier.

Once purchased, insurance is non-refundable. Participants have the option of increasing coverage prior to travel date. Malcolm Travel & Cruise recommends passengers purchase insurance at time of initial deposit. Insurance can be purchased up to 24 hours prior to departure date, but will not include pre-existing conditions, Terrorist Incident in a U.S. city or financial default of a supplier

Cancellation/Interruption Insurance protection provides reimbursement for non-refundable trip payments and deposits charged by the airline and/or Carnival Cruise Line, if your trip is cancelled or interrupted for illness, death or other specific unforeseen circumstances.

Insurance Policy also provides additional coverage including:

- Emergency medical/Dental coverage – up to \$30,000
- Emergency Medical Transportation – up to \$100,000
- Baggage loss/damage – Benefits included loss, damage or theft of baggage and personal effects, up to \$1000
- Baggage delay – Covers the additional purchase of essential items if your baggage is delayed or misdirected by a common carrier for 24 hours or more, up to \$200
- Travel delay – Receive up to \$750 per person to cover additional accommodations and travel expenses due to a Travel Delay of six or more hours.
- Travel Accident – up to \$25,000
- Missed connection – Expenses resulting from a covered delay, up to \$750

REQUIRED TRAVEL DOCUMENTS:

Effective *December 31, 2007*, the US Government will require that all travelers be in possession of a valid passport when traveling to or from the Caribbean, Mexico, Canada, and Bermuda. Passport **MUST** be valid for 6 months ***AFTER*** your scheduled return date. NAMES MUST MATCH EXACTLY AS ON YOUR PASSPORT.
